

16 & 17 YEAR OLD SUMMER RESIDENCE (UK ONLY)

In London, Canterbury and Cambridge we offer a fully supervised residence for 16 & 17 year olds in July and August. This comes with a bespoke social programme designed for this age group as well as full board catering. The residences include breakfast, lunch and dinner at Stafford House canteens and live-in residential supervisors. This is a great alternative to homestay for students under 18.

16 & 17 YEAR OLD RESIDENCE (US ONLY)

Homestay is an excellent choice for 16 & 17 year olds studying at all four of our US locations. Minor students, with parental consent, also have the option of staying in private en-suite rooms at the Vantaggio Residence Clubs in both San Diego and San Francisco (breakfast included). In Chicago, 16 & 17 year olds who are accompanied by a chaperone or guardian may stay at the Hostelling International, and in Boston, minor students can stay at the International Guest House, where breakfast and dinner are provided.



MODULES

All students on our Standard, Intensive and Super Intensive courses can personalise their learning through the addition of specific modules. These modules run on four-week cycles and give students the ultimate flexibility, as modules are designed around what the students say they want and need.

OBJECTIVES

Our exam courses are goal-orientated and highly focussed preparation programmes, that help you develop the skills and strategies you need to maximise your score in the exam of your choice. Whether it's IELTS, TOEFL or the Cambridge Suite exams, you will finish the course with strategies to ensure you get your best score possible.

HOW YOU WILL LEARN

These courses are a mixture of language input and exam strategies. The language input is aimed at broadening your vocabulary and grammatical range, while exam strategies help you become familiar with the many question types in your exam, and learn techniques to demonstrate to the examiner your knowledge of English. Our teachers will help you understand what examiners are looking for, so you can answer the questions as effectively as possible. Classes cover all elements of the exam, and with sample papers and continuous practice of specific tasks, you will become familiar with the exam and perform at your best under time pressure.

IELTS & TOEFL

Both the IELTS (the English Language Testing System) and the TOEFL (the Test of English as a Foreign Language) are designed to test the English level of students wishing to study at an English speaking college or university, but they are also used for work and migration. You cannot pass or fail an IELTS or TOEFL; rather you get a score that tells you your level.

Both can be taken in over 130 countries around the world, and on almost every week of the year, and both will give you your results in about two weeks. IELTS is more well-known in the UK, Australia, New Zealand and Canada, whereas TOEFL is more well-known and widely accepted in the USA.

IELTS is now also the only test you can use to acquire a UK visa, when you apply from outside of the UK.

CAMBRIDGE EXAM PREPARATION

The Cambridge Suite of Exams, part of the University of Cambridge, are based on decades of unrivalled research in English Language learning, teaching and assessment. They are recognised globally by schools, universities and employers and never expire (so you don't have to take them again in two years' time).

Unlike IELTS and TOEFL, the Cambridge Suite exams are proficiency tests. This means that you must take the right test for your level. Because of this, the preparation you do for these exams really helps you improve your English, as it is aimed specifically at your level.

Stafford House is an approved testing centre for Cambridge Suite exams at all of our UK centres, as well as in our San Diego school. This means you can book and take your exams in the same place you have your lessons, which should reduce exam anxiety and help you perform better.

Stafford House offers preparation courses for the FCE, CAE and CPE exams. You can build a strong foundation with FCE and then progress through the suite to attain proficiency in English.

THE FCE

The FCE (Cambridge English: First) tests English at B2 level. This is the most popular exam in the Cambridge Suite, and it demonstrates that you can use everyday written and spoken English independently for work or study purposes.

THE CAE

The CAE (Cambridge English: Advanced) tests English at C1 level. This advanced level exam is accepted by more than 6000 education institutions, employers and government departments world wide. It shows you have reached a high level of English.
