Australian Student Visa Application

All international students must obtain a student visa to live and study in Australia. The Australian Government issues all student visas and you must meet the key criteria before a visa is granted. We advise you to contact your nearest Australian Embassy or one of our ABILITY English approved agents to find out more about the process.

ABILITY English is approved by the Australian Government to offer our courses to International students. We reserve the right to pre-screen any international applicants and this may mean that we conduct an interview with the student and/or ask for additional supporting documents. So that we can assess if students are likely to meet the GTE criteria.

Student or Genuine Temporary Entrant (GTE) requirements are established by the Department of Home Affairs (DHA). The regulations for GTE change depending on which country you are from, so it is best to check out DIBP's website if you want more information on the legal requirements of Student Visas in Australia.

Step 1

Step 2

Enrolment Form



Complete our International student enrolment form. Please make sure you fill out all required details as missing information may delay your application.

Step 3

Supporting Documentation



Please submit the required documents to support your application, some of these documents may include but not limit to:

1. Current Passport (front & back page)
2. Certificates, academic transcripts or results
3. English Language proficiency result

Step 4

Letter of Offer and Enrolment Agreement



If your application is successful, you will receive a Letter of Offer (LoO).

To complete the enrolment process, sign and submit the LoO and pay the required fees.

Step 5

Confirmation of Enrolment (eCOE)



Upon receiving your signed LoO and first payment, you will receive a Confirmation of Enrolment (eCoE). You are now ready to apply for your visa with Australian Immigration. For more info regarding how to apply for Australian Student visa please visit, www.homeaffairs.gov.au

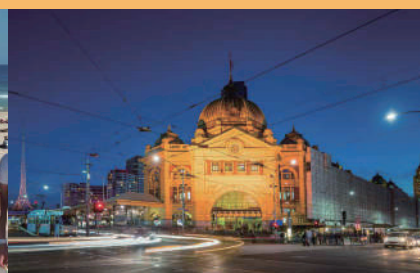
