am Language Studio offers courses in the English language at 6 levels; Beginner, Elementary, Pre-intermediate, Intermediate, Upper-intermediate and Advanced. Beginner – A1, Elementary – A1-A2, Pre Intermediate – A2 – B1, Intermediate B1, Upper Intermediate – B2, Advanced C1.

Adult Courses

General English am200101

The most popular course at am Language Studio is designed to give students a solid introduction to the English language and devotes special attention to grammar, vocabulary building, conversation and pronunciation. While conventional texts and audio equipment form the basis of the lesson structure, teachers encourage language use through role-play, problem solving, discussions and story telling. The group element allows participants to benefit from trying out and practising language structures on their fellow students.

Intensive English am200102

By devoting more hours to tuition students can give their English a kick-start in a relatively short period of time. Students follow the General English Course and have a further 2 sessions per day of 45 minutes each.

They are given the opportunity to consolidate their General English studies and have further options to cover new ground.

English Mini Group am200103a/b

This course is designed to cover the same course content as outlined in our General English Course. It offers the benefit of studying in a group but with fewer numbers, so that students have more opportunity to actively participate during the lesson and get more teacher attention than they would in larger classes. Smaller numbers offer more flexibility in planning the course content around the individual needs of the participants.

Individual English am200104

Individual lessons offer students the opportunity to make their learning more focused and pertinent to their needs. With 1 to 1 lessons students have the full and continuous attention of the teacher, and the time to practise and go over areas of their choice, thus speeding up the learning process. The Individual Course is fairly flexible in that

students can choose the number and duration of sessions according to their own preferences.

Combination English am200105

With this course students benefit from group classes in the General English Course and individual lessons when they have the teacher's undivided attention to focus on their specific needs and interests. Students choose a number of consecutive sessions of study per day.

These courses are offered at Beginner, Beginner – A1, Elementary – A1-A2, Pre Intermediate – A2 – B1, Intermediate B1 Upper Intermediate – B2, Advanced C1 levels.



Professional Courses

General Business English am200106a

As the globalisation process becomes more complete people are increasingly aware of the fact that English is the language of modern trade. This course helps students that wish to pursue a career in business by working on basic everyday situations such as answering the telephone, aspects of a meeting, presenting facts and figures, dealing with customers and corresponding professionally.

The course is designed according to students' specific needs and future objectives and is sure to help with future business development.

Intensive Business English am200106b

With this course students can maximise their studies by following a more intensive programme. The course is designed to let students cover new material on the basis of what they already know. By devoting more hours to tuition, students can give their Business English a real kick-start in a relatively short period of time.

Business English Mini Group

am200106c1/2

This course is designed to cover the same course content as outlined in our General Business and Intensive Business courses. Smaller numbers encourage more teacher attention. Enrolling in a mini group ensures a larger amount of teachr attention with more flexibility in planning the course content around individual Business English needs.

Individual Business English am200106d

Individual lessons with the full and continuous attention of the teacher offer students the opportunity to practise and go over areas of their choice. Students with a clear idea of their future business career path can tailor their lessons with their teacher to their chosen field. The number and duration of the sessions can be set according to their own preferences.

Combination Business English am200106e

This course is an ideal way for students to combine a Business English course with individual attention. Students have the opportunity to develop their general language ability in group classes and focus on specific areas of Business English with their teacher in individual sessions.

Intensive Business English Mini Group + Individual Tuition am200106f

With this course students follow the Intensive Business English Course with even smaller numbers in the classroom to benefit from more teacher attention and then follow it up further with individual tuition. This programme offers students the opportunity to progress their Business English rapidly and really concentrate on their individual development.

These courses are offered at Pre-Intermediate A1-B1, Intermediate B1, Upper Intermediate B2 and (ADD) Advanced C1 levels.





Teacher Training and IWB Refresher Course

This course is based on helping people working in the Education profession to refresh and improve upon their skills and knowledge. The lesssons cover needs targeted at the following levels: Pre-Intermediate B1, Intermediate B2, Upper-Intermediate C1 and Advance C2.

ESP Courses (English for Specific Purposes)

Our ESP (English for Specific Purposes) Courses consist of Medical English, Legal English and English for Tourism, or any other particular subject a group may wish to study. The courses are designed according to participants' specific needs and their future objectives. Students are given the opportunity to improve their ability to communicate in English, using generic jargon whether medical, legal, that used in the tourism sector, or any other specialist field.

These courses are offered at Intermediate B1, Upper Intermediate B2 and Advanced C1 levels as you should have a good standard of English before enrolling on one of our ESP courses.

Medical English

For students with a medical vocation, our Medical English Courses are designed according to your specific needs and future objectives. The courses allow you to improve your ability to communicate in English in a medical environment using generic medical jargon. Attention is given to students' specific requirements relative to their chosen profession.

Legal English

For students with a legal career, or working within a legal administrative area, our Legal English Courses are designed to help you use English in a legal context. The courses allow you to improve your ability to communicate in English in a legal environment using generic legal jargon. Attention is given to students' specific needs.

General English for Tourism

These courses are designed for students working in the tourism sector who would like to improve their English communication skills in an environment pertaining to the hotel industry, food & beverage and tourism sectors. The courses may cover general aspects of the tourism sector, or may focus on specific areas depending on the needs of the course participants.

Any Specialist Subject

Long Stay / Academic Year Courses

Our Long Stay Courses offer students the opportunity to practise and develop their English language more thoroughly over an extensive period of time, focusing on fluency, grammar, vocabulary, conversation and pronunciation. Using modern course books and a wide range of our resource materials, they can expect to participate in pair and group work, and take on an active role in the classroom. While conventional texts and audio equipment form the basis of the lesson structure, teachers encourage language use through role-play, problem solving, discussions and story telling.

The courses are designed to help students improve their reading, writing, listening and speaking skills, increase their English vocabulary and give them more confidence with the English language. They put the knowledge they gain in class to everyday use and make steady progress through each level. Students can follow either the General English Course, or the Intensive English Course.

They are offered at all levels and in periods of 8, 12, 24 and 36 weeks. The longer the course, the better the prospects of becoming fluent in the English language.

These courses are offered at Beginner, Beginner – A1, Elementary – A1-A2, Pre Intermediate – A2 – B1, Intermediate B1, Upper Intermediate – B2, Advanced C1 levels.

General English

This course is designed to give students a solid introduction to the English language and devotes special attention to grammar, vocabulary building, conversation and pronunciation. While conventional texts and audio equipment form the basis of the lesson structure, teachers encourage language use through role-play, problem solving, discussions and story telling. The group element allows participants to benefit from trying out and practising language structures on their fellow students.

Intensive English

By devoting more hours to tuition, students can give their English a kick-start in a relatively short period of time. Students follow the General English Course and have a further 2 sessions per day of 45 minutes each. They are given the opportunity to consolidate their General English studies and have further options to cover new ground.

Exam Preparation Courses

With the world fast becoming a smaller place, it is now more common for non-native English speakers to attend an English-speaking university, or to migrate to an English-speaking country. Students interested in sitting for an internationally recognised examination can take an Examination Preparation Course with am Language Studio covering the major examinations; the Cambridge Examination Courses plus IELTS, TOEFL, TOLES and WEFT. These courses are available all year round.

Courses vary from 4 to 12 weeks depending on the examination, and the needs and level of the applicant. Spread over 20, 25 or 30 sessions a week, each session being 45 minutes long, participants focus on grammar awareness and use of language. They develop their four skills of reading, listening, writing and speaking and also concentrate on more specific examination subject requirements.



Exam Preparation Courses (Cambridge)

BEC (Business English Certificate) Exam Preparation Course

BEC is offered at two levels. Vantage and Higher. BEC examinations are ideal, if students are preparing for a career in business. An internationally recognised business qualification can help show that they have learned English to an appropriate standard and can use it in a professional context. The course covers all aspects of Business English with a focus on exam preparation for the BEC Cambridge exams. It includes writing reports, speaking on the phone, presenting in English and using formal vocabulary. The course is designed to give students all they need to interact through English in a business work environment and so open up job opportunities.

This course is offered at Intermediate B1, Upper Intermediate B2 and Advanced C1 levels.

FCE (First Certificate in English) Exam Preparation Course

FCE is at Level 3 in the Cambridge five level system. This course has widespread recognition in commerce and industry such as public or secretarial work in banking, airlines, catering and hospitality. It is also recognised by some university faculties, colleges and other educational institutions as fulfilling English language requirements.

This course is offered at Intermediate B1, And Upper Intermediate B2 levels.

CAE (Certificate in Advanced English) Exam Preparation Course

CAE is at Level 4 in the Cambridge five level system. This course indicates a high level of language competence for candidates wishing to use English for professional or study purposes. It is recognised by the majority of British universities and higher education institutions as fulfilling entrance requirements in English language.

This course is offered at Advanced C1 level.

CPE (Certificate of Proficiency in English) Exam Preparation Course

CPE is at Level 5 in the Cambridge five level system. This course indicates an advanced level of competence which is recognised as fulfilling entrance requirements in English language to British universities and many universities in other English-speaking countries, and by other institutions of higher education and professional bodies worldwide. In a number of countries the CPE provides exemption from local English language requirements, or is a qualification for admission to courses or employment where a thorough knowledge of English is required.

This course is offered at Advanced C1 Plus level.

Exam Preparation Courses (Other)

IELTS (International English Language Testing System) Exam Preparation Course

IELTS is administered jointly by The British Council, IDP Education Australia and the University of Cambridge Local Examinations Syndicate. It is designed to assess the language ability of candidates who need to study or work where English is used as the language of communication. It covers all four language skills at nine levels from nonuser to expert user. IELTS scores are widely accepted by educational institutions, can be used as entry to training courses and are recognised by other services and businesses such as immigration and recruitment. This course can be taken as General English or Intensive English.

TOEFL (Test of English as a Foreign Language) Exam Preparation Course

This is an American examination. TOEFL

scores are required for purposes of admission by more than 2,400 colleges and universities in the United States and Canada. In Europe, TOEFL is also used by institutions where English is the language of instruction. Many government agencies, scholarship programmes, and licensing/certification agencies use TOEFL scores to evaluate English proficiency.

TOLES (Test of Legal English Skills) Exam Preparation Course

The TOLES examinations were developed to meet the demand from law firms, companies, legal institutions, lawyers and law students for an accurate method of assessing an individual's legal English. TOLES has been developed by legal professionals with expertise in English language training. It is the result of extensive consultation with law firms and institutions, and is regularly revised to reflect the on-going changes that occur within the legal profession.

WEFT (Written English for Tourism) Exam Preparation Course

Set by LCCI (London Chamber of Commerce Institute), WEFT tests a candidate's skills to communicate effectively in English at customer liaison level for the hospitality, travel and tourism industries.

It examines a student's ability to work effectively at a professional level, using spoken and written business communication conducted in English.

These courses are offered at Intermediate B1, Upper Intermediate B2 and Advanced C1 levels.

The e-learning course has been developed as a follow-up course for students who have already attended an EFL course with am Language Studio at the levels indicated below. The course includes interactive learning activities for students to work through independently, offering them further opportunity for practice in areas of grammar that they may have already studied during their language course at am Language Studio.

At each level, the course is designed to give students more of a challenge, extending their learning potential.
