NEW ZEALAND

With a worldwide reputation for a clean, green environment, stunning natural beauty and friendly welcoming people, our beautiful country will definitely live up to your expectations.

COROMANDEL PENINSULA

Situated only two and a half hours from Auckland city, the Coromandel Peninsula, with its forests, golden beaches and vast stretches of rugged coastline, is one of the most beautiful areas of NZ.

WHITIANGA

Whitianga is a small, safe, seaside town. It is a popular holiday destination and has an excellent variety of restaurants, bars and cafes. The local people enjoy a relaxed lifestyle which often includes ocean activities such as fishing, surfing and boating. Students are often surprised and delighted by how informal and friendly their host families are. Relaxing at the beach, watching the night sky, exploring the bush and coastline are all part of our students' enjoyment of Whitianga.

THE SCHOOL

COLC is located in a renovated old Kauri villa beside the Whitianga harbour and only a few minutes walk from the centre of town. The original part of the building is one of the oldest houses in town and is surrounded by beautiful grounds that are available for games and students' recreation. Free Wi-Fi is available throughout the school.





COURSES

Improving your English skills is our priority and our highly qualified teachers provide excellent learning opportunities for each student. Our courses are designed on a student-centred basis and our curriculum is a dynamic statement that reflects our philosophy about learning and teaching. Small class sizes encourage more individual attention, as well as ensuring great progress and an instant sense of belonging when you enter the classroom.

GENERAL COURSE

Our standard course is 21 hours a week of skills based and conversation classes, combined with the opportunity to go out into the community and practice your English in real life situations. Morning lessons, form the basis of all our courses. Newly learnt vocabulary and grammar is consolidated in conversation classes and students take part in a weekly whole school activity that really puts their communication skills to the test. Afternoon classes are 1.5 hours of tuition that can range from creative projects, town surveys, or topics such as business or fashion, to film making or drama. This variety only adds to the fun of learning English.

EXAMINATION PREPARATION COURSE

COLC specialises in FCE. There is a 12 week starting early September, and a 10 week course starting at the beginning of April. Normal morning lessons will be followed by 2 hours of intensive exam preparation Monday to Thursday. The course will include exam tasks and intensive tuition, as well as examination strategies and techniques. A minimum of 4 students is required to run these courses.

ENGLISH PLUS ACTIVITIES – NEW LOWER PRICED ACTIVITY PROGRAM

This is the course our great reputation has been built on. Now the program offers even better value for money and the new format makes activities available to all those who want to try them. This course combines morning lessons 5 days a week, with outdoor activities on 3 afternoons. Additional activities will be available on some Fridays and Saturdays, which students can join and pay for if they choose. "Learning by Doing" is English learning in action!

ENGLISH PLUS COURSES

COLC provides a range of English Plus courses where students do morning lessons and a special activity in the afternoons, such as NZ cooking, golf or bone-carving. Most of these courses have one to one tuition for the activity and can be booked on a weekly basis.

ENGLISH PLUS ENVIRONMENTAL VOLUNTEERING

ACTIVITIES

COLC has always provided outstanding activity options and the programme now includes 3 activities per week, throughout the summer months of October till April. At times if there is a demand, we will provide extra activities on Fridays and sometimes Saturdays. These extra activities will be optional to everyone and students will just pay for the ones they choose to do. Activities allow you to keep learning by using your English while having great fun, and seeing and doing new and exciting things.



On activities our experienced teachers will share with you their intimate knowledge of the local environment and you will visit wonderful marine and rural locations that other visitors to the Peninsula may not have access to. We provide a range of interesting activities that showcase the things you can do on the Coromandel Peninsula, from surf experience and boogie boarding to beach visits and bush walks. There will always be a COLC activity teacher with you on activities and you will be with a group of students to share the experience.

COLC also has a strong "environmental awareness" and students will have the opportunity to join projects planting native trees, and helping to protect kiwis.



ACCOMMODATION

HOMESTAY

We regard homestay as a very important part of our programme. Our host families feel that they are part of the school, and enjoy the privilege of having students from other cultures to stay with them. The school ensures that the homes are of a high standard, and that families are made aware of the challenges which foreign students face in adapting to New Zealand life. Unless specially requested, we do not place two students of the same nationality with the same host family.

LITTLE PARADISE LODGE

Students can also stay at the Little Paradise Lodge, just a 5 minute walk from school, where they will have a comfortable room and can share the well equipped kitchen. This is a friendly and enjoyable option for students who do not wish to stay with a family.

STUDENT HOUSE

COLC also has a student house available. This is a 3 bedroom house that students can book a room in. All facilities including WiFi are available and the living arrangements are similar to flatting. Strict house rules apply, and this option would suit students looking for quiet independence.





OPEN NIGHT

Every Thursday night the school is open for a supervised social gathering. COLC is a small school, everyone knows one another, so open nights are a fun way to welcome new students into the COLC family and provide a further opportunity to practise English in a social setting.

Open night activities are often initiated by the students themselves and we have had regular BBQs, games evenings, international meals prepared by different student groups, movies, music, singing and dancing. Whatever we do, open nights are always popular and well attended.

QUALITY CRITERIA AND AFFILIATIONS

Like all well established NZ schools, COLC is registered by NZQA and accredited to provide 'English as a Foreign Language' under section 259 of the NZ Education Act 1989.

COLC is rated by NZQA as a "Category One School". This means that if you attend our school for 14 weeks or more you can work part time in New Zealand.

COLC is a member of IALC (International Association of Language Centres), which is an association of quality, independent language schools from all around the world.

If you wish to travel earlier or later in the day than 2:00pm, you will need to book a charter which will cost **\$270**. It may be cheaper to stay one night in Auckland.
