CLASSROOM ENVIRONMENT

Full time: Monday to Friday, 3 hours per day, 15 hours per week.

This is the most popular option providing a good balance of free and study time.

Part time: Monday to Friday, any 3 days of your choice, 9 hours per week.

This option is convenient for students who work or have a smaller budget.

Intensive: Monday to Friday, 6 hours per day, 30 hours per week.

This is the best option if you need to improve your English in a short amount of time.

Evening Classes: 3 days a week, 2 hours per day, 6 hours per week.



ABOUT THE SCHOOL

Where is the school located?

Where better to study than in the heart of London? The school is based on Oxford Street just short walk moments from Tottenham Court Road tube station.

Oxford Street is a major road in the borough of Westminster in the West End of London. It is Europe's busiest shopping street, and as of 2011, boasts approximately 300 shops.

Is the school accredited?

We are accredited by the British Council and the ISI (Independent Schools Inspectorate) so all of our teachers are fully-qualified.

COURSES

How do I register for a course?

Please complete the online registration form. You will normally receive a confirmation by email within a few hours.

Can I start my course on dd.mm.yyyy?

We have availability for all courses and you can start your class any Monday. If Monday is a public holiday then courses start on Tuesday.

Can I start my course on a day other than Monday?

Wherever possible, you should try to start your English course on a Monday. However, it is also possible to start in the middle of the week when you are not able to arrive on a Monday.

Will I get a certificate at the end of my course?

Every student receives a statement of attendance at the end of his course. It states the duration of the course as well as the student's level of English.

TEACHERS AND STAFF

What qualifications do the teachers have?

All our teachers have had CELTA or Trinity CERT teacher training and regularly attend in-house Teacher Development sessions.

What teaching methods does your school use?

Our school uses a variety of student centred teaching methods/approaches to provide our students with valuable practice in all skills and language systems.

BOOKINGS AND ACCOMMODATION

How far in advance do I have to make my booking?

For the biggest choice of accommodation options please book as early as possible but, in general, it is also possible to enrol on a course at fairly short notice.

How close are the host families to the school?

Most of our host families do not live within walking distance from the school but in one of the lovely suburbs in south London. You can choose if you want to stay with a family in zone 1, 2, or 3.

All our host families are close to public transport. You will travel up to 60 minutes to school depending on the travel zone you choose.

What happens if I don't like my accommodation?

Should there be any problems with the host family, we will help you to solve them and if necessary, you can change your accommodation.
