
1-1 tutorials half-way through your programme or monthly for long-term courses and again at the end of the course to ensure that the student's individual goals are being reached.







Cork City, located 2.5 hours from Dublin on the south coast of Ireland, is a safe & youthful city with friendly people who simply love to talk! University College Cork, an 1845 University retaining its original school buildings as well as new modern buildings, is ideally located just 15 minutes' walk from Cork city centre. The excellent sports complex on the campus houses an indoor swimming pool, tennis courts, climbing wall, indoor and outdoor running tracks, dance & spin studios and extensive pitches.

ACCOMMODATION & MEALS




