

Airport Transfers

With advanced notice we can help you to arrange airport transfers from Manchester Airport at an additional fee. We can also arrange this from London airports, but it will be very expensive. If travelling from London, it is best to come by train or coach as they are much cheaper.

For travel from Leeds Bradford Airport, we recommend booking a taxi at the taxi stand in the Arrivals area of the airport. This will be very cost-effective if you are travelling to a location within Leeds, such as Carr Mills Student Halls of Residence.

During the week, we arrange activities such as bowling, cinema nights, school sporting events, and school parties like barbecues during the summer months.






